Solar eclipse 4/8 interesting facts:

-Manchester will only get to 90% obscured, but on 9/14/2099 the western tip of Maryland will get a total eclipse.

No Den Meeting on 4/1.

-Maryland will also get a total eclipse in 2079, but it will be before the sun even comes up, the most people will notice is that the morning will be darker than normal. -The sun is only safe to look at with the naked eye during totality, solar glasses should be used at all other times to look at the sun.

### Scouting Fun Fact:

The Kansas City Chiefs Football Team was named in honor of "The Chief" Harold Roe Bartle, who was partly responsible for the team being relocated from Dallas. Texas to Kansas City.

H. Bartle Roe was the BSA Scout Executive of the Kansas City Area Council from 1928-1955 and said he had been inducted into a local Arapaho tribe and used the name Chief Lone Bear.











The Udvar-Hazy Center is the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum annex at the Dulles Airport. The museum is a 346,774 square foot facility and has exhibits such as the Enola Gay, the plane that dropped the first atomic bomb, the Space Shuttle Discovery, a SR-71 Blackbird

(the X-Men plane), and a prototype F-35 Lightning II fighter jet.
